

Hiltz Movers Is Growing Firm

One of Gloucester's growing moving firms is R. C. Hiltz, with offices at 285 Main Street.

Robert Hiltz started in the moving business in 1913 when he was employed by Ford's Express. In those days, before automobiles were in general use, moving was done by horse drawn vehicles. In 1915 Hiltz became associated with the National House Furniture Co. here, moving furniture and equipment for the firm, at first by horse and later, in 1914, when the company changed over to automobiles.

HILTZ, ALTHOUGH he specializes in moving in New England, has also moved furniture and appliances to New York and New Jersey. The firm employs three regular men, two other men are on call.

Hiltz is married to the former Bessie Larsen. The couple have a son Robert, who works with his father in the moving business, and a daughter Phyllis Ciaramitaro, whose husband is also associated with Hiltz. There are three granddaughters and three grandsons.
