

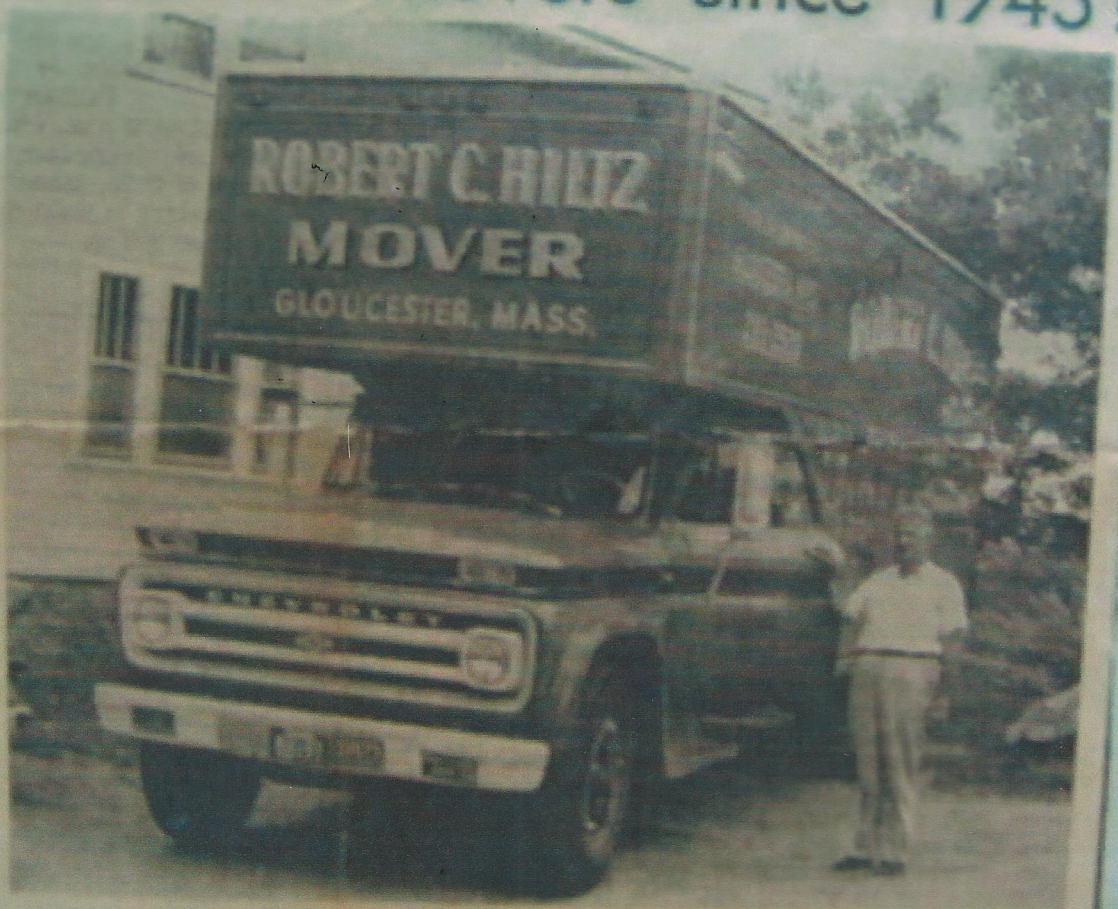
# Robert C. Hiltz . . . movers since 1943!
